It will be hosted in Malaysia for the first time this year, reckoning local wisdom and regional approaches in promoting academia-industry-government-society cooperation to inspire innovative breakthroughs towards positive futures of sustainability and wellbeing. Catering researchers, practitioners, and policymakers all together, the conference intends to highlight futures-oriented work in the region while focusing on inter-sectoral activities in research, science, and technology for societal betterment and civilisational preservation to comprehend the changing trajectory of Asia, the emerging issues and disruptors in a decade, and the alternative futures.

Travel Arrangements and Visa

Kindly ensure the passport is sufficiently valid for the travel. An entry visa to Malaysia may be obtained via MYVisa where the Frequently Asked Questions are also available on the same page. Please contact us if you need Visa support such as an official document.

All participants are expected to plan their own travel arrangements and cover all expenses incurred (e.g.: visa fee, transportation costs, accommodations).

Transportation

• From Kuala Lumpur International Airports (KLIA & KLIA2) to KL Sentral

Upon arrival at the Kuala Lumpur International Airports (KLIA & KLIA2), you can find the KLIA Ekspres service which directly links the airports to KL Sentral (Kuala Lumpur City Centre). It runs every 20 minutes during weekday peak hours and every 30 minutes during weekday off-peak hours, on weekends and national public holidays. You can purchase a train ticket in cash or by credit card (Visa or MasterCard) at the KLIA Ekspres counters. The journey time between KL Sentral and KLIA T1 is 28 minutes, and 3 minutes between

KLIA T1 and KLIA T2. Please visit the official website for the latest updates on the fares, etc. <u>here</u>. It is advisable to check the latest schedule before your travel.

• From KL Sentral to the International Youth Centre (IYC), Kuala Lumpur

Taxi and e-hailing services are available at KL Sentral at your convenience. While taxis can easily be found at the main entrance of KL Sentral, you are alternatively recommended to use <u>Grab e-hailing mobile app</u> for reputably safe rides with verified drivers, upfront pricing, and a wide range of vehicles to choose from depending on the size of your group. The following steps can be followed to create an account on <u>Grab</u>:

To start using Grab services, you can create a Grab account:

- 1. Download and install Grab app from Play Store (Android) / App Store (iOS)
- 2. Choose one account creation (Google, Facebook, or Phone Number)
- 3. Complete all required data with an active email/Facebook account and phone number
- 4. You will receive an SMS OTP containing a 4-digit code (IMPORTANT! Please do not disclose this code to anyone, including persons acting on behalf of Grab)

When you make the first booking, Grab will ask you to verify by choosing one of the following 3 ways below:

Verify with Facebook

Please complete one of the 3 verification methods to avoid account abuse in the future.

On the other hand, public transportation in Kuala Lumpur and the Klang Valley can be traced via the Myrapid PULSE app. Currently, the app covers the MRT, LRT, KL Monorail, Sunway BRT, and buses under the Rapid KL, including the MRT feeder buses.
